The return to work for 2023 has seen quite a number of challenges thrown at us, not in the least the very hot and humid conditions. It's important to ensure that you stay well hydrated until the cooler months are upon us. However, having said that, this year's welcome back is much more delightful than this time last year, when we were going through the Omicron outbreak.

One Day - 1,000 Trips!

Traditionally the heat plays havoc for our North Queensland clients, and trips are normally subdued but this year, everyone is certainly getting out and about. Both Cairns and Townsville are being kept very busy and across Brisbane, Townsville and Cairns we even reached one day with 1,000 trips!

Front Seat Only Car Travel

A number of our clients prefer travelling in the front seat of our cars. I would like to remind everyone that we only have 30 cars in our fleet and the front seats of these vehicles need to be available for people with a physical disability which prevents them sitting anywhere else.

All other clients are asked to sit in the back to leave the front seats available for those with these impairments. Clients who have a physical disability requiring front seat travel must have their doctor complete a medical declaration form. We can only accept our completed form which is available from the Contact Centre.

Wearing a Seatbelt is the Law

I'd like to remind everyone that all clients must wear a seatbelt and wear it properly (across the shoulder) when travelling with TransitCare. This means when the vehicle is moving or stationary, including when stopped at traffic lights. You will be required to wear your seatbelt to travel unless you have on your person, a seatbelt exemption certificate. See your doctor if you require this documentation. Failure to comply and wear it properly on the shoulder (not under the arm) means that you risk being fined \$1,000. Our drivers will not be responsible for these fines.

Changes Are Coming – Ensure You Are Registered with My Aged Care

It is important that all clients 65 years and over are registered with My Aged Care to travel with TransitCare. Commencing in March 2023, our team will be reviewing the registration of all clients accessing services and will give you a call to assist you to register if you haven't already done so.

TransitCare Community Hub (Logan Clients Only)

We encourage any of our Logan clients who are feeling socially isolated, to join in the fun at our TransitCare Community Hub. The hub operates from Tuesday to Friday and we currently have vacancies available. Further information is available on page 10.

TransitCare Notification App

The TransitCare notification app is on the way! This platform will deliver a message to your mobile phone, notifying you when your vehicle is approaching. This will give you peace of mind, knowing that the vehicle is on the way. It will also alert you for a booked trip, in case this has slipped your mind, and it saves you calling the office to see where your vehicle might be. This app will be rolled out in stages starting in our regions and later moving to Brisbane. Further information will be available in the next edition of this magazine.

BUS TRIPS UPDATE

Improvements to Bus Trips (Social Support and **Community Flyer Adventures)**

As you may see, the team have worked hard to improve some of the bus trips, so the travel time is not as long. Once the changes commence in 2023, we will be keen to hear your feedback.

We have several people travelling on bus trips that require a front seat and car only.

Please note that if you have this requirement in place for your everyday travel with us, you may not be able to access these bus trips as again, these are long trips and considered not suitable for someone requiring a front seat car only on a lesser journey.

New to Bus Trips? What You Need to Know

In order to book a social support trip you need to:

1. Contact My Aged Care and obtain a referral code to Social Support Group services.

Contact My Aged Care and obtain a referral code for Transport Services.

You will not be able to book an expression of interest for a trip until you have provided TransitCare with both codes.

FINANCE UPDATE

Referencing Your Invoice Payments

Our Finance Team have noticed over the last few months an increase in the number of invoice payments that are being paid with no reference number. This applies to both EFT payments and payments made directly at a Westpac branch. As you can imagine, no reference details make it impossible for our revenue reconciliation team to correctly allocate the payments to the right client.

To assist us in ensuring all payments are allocated correctly, when you are paying invoices, please include in the reference field the invoice number you are paying. You can find your invoice number located directly on your invoice either underneath your name and address or underneath our EFT details.

How We Correspond With You

When we contact you regarding invoice queries or payment, we will never correspond with you demanding payment via text messaging.

Several clients were contacted via text over the Christmas closure period but these texts did not originate from TransitCare. If TransitCare does need to correspond with a client in relation to queries or payment, it will only be via their preferred method of communication which we have on file. Furthermore, if any client does receive a text demanding payment going forward, please contact Robyn Kleinschmidt (Finance Manager) by calling 1300 153 636.

TOWNSVILLE UPDATE

MEET A MEMBER – RON SAUNDERS

I was born 19 November 1927 at Cleethorpes, a seaside town near Grimsby, Lincolnshire, UK, then the largest fishing port in the world, home to some 300 steam trawlers. I saw the last of the great depression, and WWII from start to finish. I got a carpentry apprenticeship at 14, there was a lot of work, new and repairs due to damage by enemy raids, and post-war, the building boom. I loved the countryside, cycling and walking tours, and went on hiking adventures to Switzerland, Denmark and Sweden. I also enjoyed Modern Ballroom and Old-Time dancing. I immigrated to New Zealand when I turned 21, I'm a 10-pound Pom. The ship departed Southampton 26 November 1947 and arrived in Wellington on 10 January 1950. My first NZ job was as a carpenter at Kaingaroa Sawmill, Rotorua. After that I worked all over including: Tokoroa building a new town for timber workers, Waikato Maraetai Hydro Dam building houses for staff, Dargaville Northland, working on a new base hospital at Tauranga, Bay of Plenty working in joinery shops. By this time I was almost a Kiwi.

While at Tauranga, I met a lovely lady whose name was Christina, and we married on 16 June 1956. We built our first home and adopted our daughter, Fiona and son, Craig.

In 1964 and we moved to Manurewa, in South Auckland, to set up a joinery business with a friend – producing door and window frames, kitchen and bathroom cabinets etc. The building trade was unreliable for a family man so I applied to Alcan, Manukau and a totally new life opened up to me. Working machinery on an industrial scale, stamping out blanks for pot pans, snap tops for drink cans, rolling foil for milk bottle tops etc. I worked my way from the floor, to chargehand, foreman, quality controller etc. I stayed for 16 years and retired at 60 on a NZ pension. During this time, we built our second home. Our daughter, Fiona, visited Townsville, met her husband, and put down roots here. Chris and I decided to follow. so I designed and built a 21' Motorhome, packed our belongings inside, sold up anything else and shipped the vehicle to Sydney. We flew over to start a new chapter in our lives. Fiona and her family settled in Deeragun, while Chris and I did the round trip of Australia twice, North and South, and East and West, some 170,000km in all. We were foundation members of CMCA (Campervan Motorhome Club Australia) Q236. Our wanderlust and touring of this large country means there's not a lot of places we missed.

When we weren't travelling, we built home



number three on the family acreage ready for the quiet life of retirees. Sadly, Chris passed away in Nov. 2017 after 61 years together (just made the Queen's list for our 60th anniversary).

Currently I attend various community functions with TransitCare who cater for us young at heart, with meet and greets at our pub lunches and other outings. This is all due to the friendly drivers taking us out and about in the Community Flyer vehicles. Nothing is too much trouble, and many have become friends.
