Welcome to the Winter Edition of TOGETHER Magazine.

Please understand that our drivers are not being rude when they advise clients that they cannot wait and must move on – they simply have another client they need to pick up.

As we head once again into winter, we are also heading into the flu season. It is important to make sure that you have had your flu shot. Book an appointment with your GP or the chemist for your jab if you haven't yet done so. We are very happy to get you to and from these appointments.

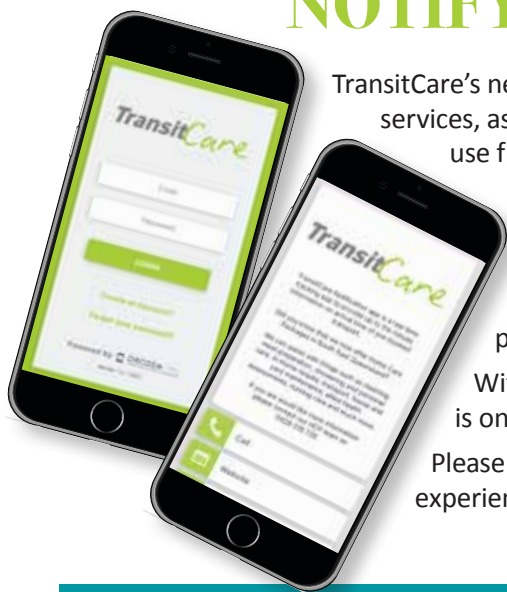
NOTIFY APP COMING TO TRANSITCARE

TOWNSVILLE UPDATE

MEET A MEMBER – OWEN T JONES (OT)

I grew up in the Western Australian railway town of Midland, and had a long-term involvement with the Scouting movement, which I believe gave me leadership skills which helped me in my later years. I completed a plumbing apprenticeship and once qualified, I joined a plumber friend in Mt. Hagen, New Guinea, where we developed a plumbing and sheet metal factory, with branches in Madang and Goroka.

I met my wife, Beth in this highland centre, and we married in 1966. Beth had been working as a nursing sister in the local hospital. I was privileged to be one of the first foreigners to be elected to the Mt Hagen Local Council, which brought together all the local tribal clans. I learnt from one of the local leaders how to think in different cultures regarding beliefs and taboos. That leader was awarded the Order of the British Empire from our late Queen for uniting the tribes.

In 1973, just prior to independence, we sold the business and Beth and I moved with our two children, Andrew and Wanda, to Townsville when IPEX Plastics offered me a job to open a new branch.

In 1982 I became involved with the Housing

Industry Authority (HIA) group scheme and looked after 12 apprentices. It was here I saw a need for a different way to train and organise apprentices as the construction industry was moving into a sub-contractor based system, and few builders could guarantee four years work to fully train an apprentice. In 1984 we started Townsville Regional Group Apprenticeship Scheme (TORGAS), which operated in the Bowen, Charters Towers and Townsville areas. This allowed builders and other tradespeople to take on apprentices short-term, which helped them as well as giving the apprentice a more well-rounded experience, and we'd give them in-house training also – win-win.

Over time, TORGAS expanded to include other trades, like hospitality. Since TORGAS started, they would have trained well over 10,000 young people. Many of these are now running their own businesses and taking on apprentices of their own. I assisted and supported other group training services to get up and running in Cairns, Mt. Isa, Darwin, just to name a few. I was also involved nationally, serving as state President.

I also got together with Garth Harrigan and John Gilholm, when we saw a need for a



community-based transport service for older people. This involved setting up a business plan for TOTTS, which over time has morphed into TransitCare Community Flyer.

Not one to sit still for long, after retirement I finally got to finish all those jobs on the never-ending to-do list around the house. I also enjoy sailing and fishing, attending the theatre, volunteering at IMPACT Employment, an employment service for people with a disability, and spending time with the grandchildren and more recently, great-grandchildren.

That's the secret – "you've got to keep planning stuff"!
