### **New Telephone System**

TransitCare introduced a new telephone system in mid-June to improve the services we offer to our increasing number of clients. This will ensure that people phoning us won't have to wait online for extended periods of time. Apart from minor teething problems, it's "all systems go" with a dramatic improvement in answering times and a decrease in waiting times. Clients can help us by leaving a message in our message bank for non-urgent communications and can also help by not making multiple calls to ask about vehicles. This will allow us the opportunity to get back to you as quickly as possible. In 2022, we delivered around 269,000 trips, and each of these trips involved a phone call, so you can appreciate that we are all incredibly grateful for our new system.

### **TransitCare Community Hub**

Our Social Support Community Hub group has moved offsite to a centre in Loganlea. Whilst this is a disappointment to us in the building, the feedback from our clients is that they absolutely love it. Should you wish to join in our Community Hub fun and activities, please give our Contact Centre a call and come and join the fun!

### **Vehicle Approaching Notification is Near**

We have commenced a controlled trial of our Vehicle Approaching Notification System which sends an SMS message to your mobile phone as soon as the driver completes the job immediately before you. Clients will only receive notifications if they opt into this service. All clients need to do is tell a client

services representative that they would like to use the service when booking a trip and the system can be turned on.

## FROM THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT REFERENCING YOUR INVOICE PAYMENTS

# TRANSITCARE IS COMING TO THE GOLD COAST!

In September 2023 TransitCare further expanded our services in South East Queensland. Following our previous success in both Townsville and Cairns, we are now establishing a branch at the Gold Coast to provide better connections for this community.

We can assist with transport to hospital and medical appointments, the pharmacy, general shopping and groceries, the bank and post office, the gym, swimming, the library, the hairdresser and personal grooming, social and recreational outings, and visiting family and friends.

We will be focusing on areas around the Gold Coast University Hospital and the surrounding health precinct, with travel as far north as Coomera and as far south as Pacific Fair.

Specifically, we will collect from the following suburbs: Arundel, Ashmore, Benowa, Biggera Waters, Boykambil, Broadbeach, Broadbeach Waters, Bundall, Carrara, Chevron Island, Coomera, Cypress Gardens, Gaven, Hollywell, Hope Island, Isle of Capri, Labrador, Main Beach, Maudsland, Miami Keys, Molendinar, Nerang, Oxenford, Pacific Pines, Paradise Point, Paradise Waters, Parkwood, Runaway Bay, Sanctuary Cove, Santa Barbara, Sorrento, Southport, Studio Village, Surfers Paradise and Upper Coomera.

Bookings can be made between 7.00am and 6.00pm, Mondays to Fridays and must be made by 10.00 am, two working days before you wish to travel.

## IMPORTANT CHANGES TO GROUP TRIPS

(this article relates to the Calendar of Events on pages 6, 7 and 8).

**From July 2023, a new format for confirming attendance on group trips was implemented.**

You will now receive a text message asking you to confirm your attendance on all trips. If you do not have a mobile, you will still receive a phone call to confirm your attendance. A confirmation from you will be required at least three days prior to the trip. If no confirmation is received, your trip will be automatically cancelled. Once you have confirmed, this locks your attendance in for the trip. Any cancellations for trips that have pre-purchased tickets will still incur a cancellation fee after this confirmation date unless a replacement person can be found. You will then receive a follow up text message or phone call a couple of days prior to your trip with any trip information that you may require.

If you need to cancel your trip after confirming, please always call through the Contact Centre on 3422 7900. This is especially important when cancelling out of hours.

There has also been a change to the time that we need you to be ready from for all group trips. We require you to be ready from 6.30 am for all trips. This does not mean that you have to be waiting outside at this time, just to be dressed and ready from this time and wait inside. We understand that this does sound early, but we cannot anticipate which vehicle will be picking you up, or the route they need to take. We need to ensure that enough time is provided. E.g The Coaster doing pick ups along the way instead of a Hub pick up could mean that you are picked up from home just after 7.00 am to 7.30 am for a 9.00 am trip depending on your location.
