New Aged Care Act

The Aged Care Bill passed Parliament on 25 November 2024. The New Aged Care Act will start 1 November 2025.


From 1 November 2025 all clients of TransitCare will require a completed assessment with My Aged Care for services to continue.

We encourage all our clients funded by the Department of Health to call My Aged Care on 1800 200 422 to confirm an assessment has been completed.

My Aged Care is open: Weekdays from 8.00am to 8.00pm and Saturdays from 10.00am to 2.00pm

If you prefer a face-to-face appointment, call 1800 277 475 weekdays between 8.00am and 5.00pm (select Services Australia Centres).

If you are unsure if you are registered with My Aged Care, please call our TransitCare Intake team on 3422 7900 (from 7.00am to 6.00pm weekdays) or you can email intake@transitcare.com.au at your leisure.



The new Aged Care Act will put the rights of older people first. It includes a Statement of Rights for older people accessing aged care services. The below link will direct you to the fact sheet that summarises those rights.

MEET A MEMBER - LORRAINE TIBBS

I was born Lorraine Tappenden in Ayr (Nth Qld) in April 1937 a year or so later my younger sister was born. I started school in Ayr, but when war broke out, my father was called up, and the family moved to Brisbane. After the war, we moved back to Townsville where my father's family were. We got a house near the Ross River Meat Works. I went to Oonoonba State School and shortly after we moved to a house at Oonoonba. We'd only been there a few weeks when the 1946 flood came. The house we'd just left was inundated, while the water only came up to the top step of the house we'd just moved into.

A couple of years later my father built a new house in Mundingburra, a short distance from St. Joseph's School, so I went to school there. My parents bought a small mixed business next door to Kingsun's butcher shop at Gulliver, and when I left school in 1951, I worked in the shop. It was a 7 day/ week business and after about 3 years my parents sold the shop. I applied for a job

at Coles in Flinders St, and was trained as a cashier in the grocery dept. I had worked at Coles for 3 years and was offered a job as a cashier by the Kingsun's in their new butcher shop in Flinders Street. I have a love of cooking and won several prizes over the years for various breads & cakes.

I always loved dancing and met Norman, who became my husband, at a local Townsville dance. Norm was a plumber and after we wed, he started his own plumbing business. Several years later, Norm wanted a change and decided to learn about fibreglass boat building, so we moved to Mackay for several months, but my husband developed a skin condition from the fibreglass and he had to give that away. We returned to Townsville and restarted the plumbing business, after about 13 years, we bought a tract of land on Woodstock Road with Spring Creek running through it and a beautiful waterfall at the back of the property on Mt. Elliott, we developed the area into picnic and camping area, and called it Pangola

Park. After about 13 years we sold the business and retired, but stayed living there another 13 years.

Unfortunately, my husband became ill and passed away, and I sold the property and bought a house in Annandale (Townsville) where I still live today. Believe it or not, the Kingsun family still keep in touch and are very dear to me, even after all these years.

I still love dancing and try to go to a local dance group as often as I can, it makes you feel so young, and helps keep me fit.

I hope you enjoyed my story and look forward to seeing all my TransitCare friends at the next outing.




